By working with STPR & Team O'Neil, NEFR can now announce several special awards for the Regional Rallies.

- A. The highest Regional Competitor at the Team O'Neil Regional Rally, 19 January 2008 will receive a complementary entry to both the Mexico Regional Rally and the Berlin Regional Rally in 2008.
- B. The highest Regional Competitor at each of the 2008 STPR Regional Rallies will receive a complementary entry to both the Mexico Regional Rally and the Berlin Regional Rally in 2008.
- C. A competitor will be drawn from the top five finishers at the 2008 Mexico Regional Rally to receive a 2 day school at Team O'Neil Rally School. Must be present at the drawing to win.
- D. A competitor will be drawn from the top five at the 2008 Berlin Regional Rally to receive a 3 day school at Team O'Neil Rally School. Must be present at the drawing to win.
- E. A first time competitor will be selected as 2008 "Rookie of the Year" in Rally-America's Easter Regional Series will receive a 4 day school at Team O'Neil Rally School. Rally-America will be solely responsible for defining the qualifications. At this time the following rallies are in the Championship – Team O'Neil, STPR-Sherwood Forest, STPR-Finger Lakes, NEFR-Berlin, NEFR-Mexico, Tall Pines, and Rallye Defi Sainte-Agathe. The right to add additional RA events is reserved.

Eastern Region Rookie of the Year Award

Overview:

The Team O'Neil Rally School has generously offered to put up a prize for the 2008 Eastern Region Rookie of the year. Rally America will determine the top rookie driver at the end of the 2008 Eastern Regional season based on the following criteria:

1. To qualify, the driver must have no experience driving in stage rallies prior to January 1, 2008. Any driver applying for a new Rally America driver's license and entering the Eastern Regional Championship will be considered a rookie unless evidence of prior experience is brought to the attention of Rally America. Rally America will be the final judge of a rookie's status.
2. The "Rookie of the Year" will be the rookie driver with the most points overall at the end of the 2008 season. This may include out of region points as well as organizer points.

Questions regarding this bulletin received by Rally America from licensed Drivers and Co-Drivers will be answered in writing.
