SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

Inaugural Rally New YorkTM will take place in the town of Andes in the scenic Catskill Mountains on October 12 and 13, 2001. The event is a Coefficient 3 ClubRally and is part of the SCCA North East Division ClubRally Championship.

The course is 250 miles long with 69 miles of stages. You will encounter a variety of smooth and rough road surfaces on stages that are on par with the best special stages in the country. The roads vary from dirt to gravel and tarmac, sometimes covered with fine gravel. There will be no opportunity to change tires for tarmac stages. All stages are located within the towns of Andes and Bovina in the midst of the beautiful scenery of Catskill Mountains, New York at the time of spectacular fall foliage. Jeff Becker, a multi-time National ProRally Champion, will conduct seminar for first time competitors on Friday evening. All are welcome to attend.

This Rally would not be possible without outstanding support from the Andes Fire Department and EMS, the Margaretville Radio Club, EMS units from Bovina and other surrounding towns, the Town of Andes, the Town of Bovina and the Andes Chamber of Commerce, and without countless volunteers who unselfishly devote their time and energies to the success of the Rally.

Entry

The entry is limited to 60 cars. Entry fees include Service Crew kit and two tickets for Saturday awards dinner. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased at registration.

Registration

The Entrants must be prepared to provide the Registrar with the following documents: Driver's Licenses, SCCA ProRally License or SCCA ClubRally License or FIA Rally License, SCCA Membership Cards for the driver and the co-driver, proof of vehicle insurance with minimum coverages required by PRR, Article 1.6.C both for the competition vehicle and for the service vehicle(s), vehicle registration(s), a letter of permission to use the competition vehicle if not registered in the driver's or co-driver's name.

All participants must sign a waiver and wear the wristband during the entire event.

Scrutineering

Competitors are required to present their competition vehicle with a valid Vehicle Log Book and a record of current annual inspection, if applicable. No Vehicle Log Books will be issued at the event.

Parc Ferme

In order to facilitate the start of the rally on Saturday morning, there will be a Parc Ferme at the Andes Fire Hall. The Parc Ferme will be organized according to PRR, Article 7.3.1. Competitors

will be required to place their vehicles into the Parc Ferme on Friday night between the hours of 21:30 and 23:30. The vehicles will remain in the Parc Ferme overnight. Competitors may re-enter the Parc Ferme on Saturday morning ten minutes before their start time.

Servicing

There will be only one central service area at the Andes Fire Hall for the duration of the rally.

Rally Headquarters

Rally Headquarters is located at the Andes Fire Hall, telephone 845-676-4588. The Official Bulletin Board will be located at the Rally Headquarters starting on Friday at 14:00.

Miscellaneous

There will be no official odometer check. Competitors may calibrate their odometers using a section of the transit, to be found in the Route Book, from MTC 2 OUT to mile 7.8 (turn around in the parking area on the right after the bridge).

Organizers are contemplating a press stage for both the press photographers and invited VIPs. The participation in the press stage will be by invitation only at the sole discretion of the organizers.

Organizers may be required by the local authorities to restrict, by various means, the speed of competition vehicles on stages in a few places. If chicanes made of traffic cones are used, penalties for hitting the cones will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board before the rally.
